



# Facility guidelines and rules of conduct

## Boarding guidelines

- **Board payments are due on the first of each month.** If you cannot make it to the barn please drop off your check in the mail or use our pay pal service. For more pay pal information please go to our website at [www.facet58farm.com](http://www.facet58farm.com)
- Any damage caused at Facet 58 Farm due to the horse owner's negligence and/or his/her horse, will be charged to the horse owner.
- No one is to help him or herself to feed or bedding. (If there is an issue please see management)
- Switching tack rooms, stalls or pastures without permission is not permitted.
- Borrowing tack without the owner's consent is not permitted.
- The use of Facet 58 Farm tack can only be used with instructor's permission and must be fully cleaned, oiled and put away properly.
- In an effort to conserve, please turn off all lights when no longer needed.
- Lesson horses have the right away in the arena.
- Keep locker rooms clean, tidy and free of trash.
- No dogs allowed.
- Riding always takes preference over turnouts.
- Horses are not to be turned out and left unattended.
- Turnouts are to be limited to 15 minutes if others are waiting.
- Please do not leave your belongings out.
- You must call the blacksmith directly for your horse to be shod. Your check must be present for the blacksmith when he arrives or your horse will not be shod on that scheduled date. Please clean up after they are thru.
- Please scoop your poop.
- For Malibu barn horses, use outside cross ties.
- Please keep all gates closed.
- Main barn horses must be kept tied in front of your stall, or the cross ties.
- Please don't graze on the grass area where there are sprinklers.

## Arena guidelines

- There is no turn-out in the main arena.
- Jumps may not be moved or adjusted by anyone except instructors.
- **No one may jump without a scheduled lesson.**
- **Lesson horses have the right of way in the arena.**
- Please remember SAFETY FIRST. Keep your eyes open and be courteous to other riders.
- If there is a lesson in progress please stay to the opposite end of the arena.
- Please turn on the round pen sprinkler before use.
- No more than four horses in the main arena at once, if so please utilize other rings.

## Lesson guidelines

Facet 58 Farm is committed to providing you with a fun, friendly, and safe experience. In order to maintain the outstanding quality of horses, Horsemanship, and beautiful surroundings, we ask that you abide by the following rules and expected code of conduct.

- 24-hour notice required to cancel lessons, if not you will be charged full lesson price.
- Every rider must have a signed release form before mounting.
- Riding Students must be mounted and prepared to enter the arena at the scheduled lesson time. For customer service and horse/rider safety, late arrivals are not permitted.
- Lead-Line & walk/trot students please be ready for your instructor at time of scheduled lesson.
- Students are required to dress appropriately for riding lessons. Breeches/jodhpurs and or jeans are acceptable, no shorts. A Facet "58" Farm polo shirt\* long or short sleeves form fitting shirt. Paddock boots or Field boots are the most appropriate footwear.
- No one under the age of 16 may ride without parent, guardian or trainer supervision.
- Keep hair neatly pulled back in your helmet.
- **No one may ride or mount without a harnessed safety helmet** (SEI approved), no exceptions.
- Riding gloves are recommended.
- Riding with glasses is not recommended for safety reasons.
